CRISIS WHICH TOPPLED PRESIDENT JUAN BOSCH Y GAVINO WERE MEETING DAILY IN MID-NOVEMBER IN SAN JOAN, AT THE HOME OF JACOBO MAJULIA, FORMER DOMINICAN MINISTER OF FINANCE, IN AN EFFORT TO REACH AGREEMENT ON THE FUTURE POLICIES OF THE PARTIDO REVOLUCIONARIO DOMINICANO (PRO, DOMINICAN REVOLUTIONARY PARTY) AND TO SETTLE THE QUESTION OF WHOM THEY WILL SUPPORT AS THE PRO. PRESIDENT. INCLUDED AMONG THESE LEADERS WERE AMERICO LOPEZ CANACHO, FORMER DOMINICAN CONSUL

2. AS OF 15 NOV NO CONCRETE RESOLUTIONS OR SPECIFIC
COURSE OF ACTION WERE AGREED UPON ALTHOUGH THE UNIDENTIFIED
DOMINICANS URGED THAT THE GROUP ADOPT A PLAN OF SABOTAGE AND
GUERRILLA ACTIVITIES. SOME OF THE MEETINGS HAD BEEN CHARACTERIZED
BY LACK OF ORGANIZATION AND GENERAL CONFUSION.

3. ACCORDING TO LORA CAMACHO, BOSCH, WHO RESIDES IN AGUAS
BUENAS, PUERTO RICO, PLANNED TO VISIT SAN JUAN DURING THE THIRD
WEEK OF NOVEMBER FOR MEETINGS WITH ANGEL MIOLAN AND JUAN
CASASANOVA GARRIDO.

4. CASASANOVA, A FORMER PRD PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE,
REVEALED THAT HE PREFERRED TO REMAIN OUTSIDE THE DOMINICAN
REPUBLIC IN ORDER TO ORGANIZE A NEW POLITICAL GROUP WHICH WOULD
NOT INCLUDE SUPPORT FOR MIOLAN AS PRESIDENT OF THE PRD.
