1. AMERICAN CONTROLLED SOURCE HAVANA, CUBA IN 1953 LISTED ONE J. FERNANDEZ RETAMAR AS COMMUNIST POET AND WRITER WHO JOINED PROTEST AGAINST THE II BIENNIAL OF SPANISH-AMERICAN ART, BELONGED TO COMITE CUBANO-PRO-GUATEMALA, WAS MEMBER OF NATIONAL COMMITTEE OF PARTISANS OF PEACE OF CUBA AND TOOK LEADING PART 30 OCTOBER 1952 FUNCTION.

2. SOVIET LEGATION SURVEILLANCE REPORT, MARCH 1950 HAVANA, CUBA, REVEALED THAT ONE ROBERTO FERNANDEZ RETAMAR, A STUDENT, SON OF FERNANDEZ ROIG, RESIDING SAN FRANCISCO #19, HAVANA, CUBA, HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY POLICE FOR REVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES.
