1. Transmitted herewith are two reports dealing with Stanislaw **SMIDANSKI** and one report on Chester **MCNEIL**.

2. Headquarters' files contain no additional information on **SMIDANSKI**.

3. The attached reports present the highlights of **SMIDANSKI**'s activities which are pertinent to our current interests; however, the following items of information lend credence to the supposition that **SMIDANSKI** has had connections with the US: A report dated 4 August 1955 from [redacted] states that **SMIDANSKI**, then Charge d'Affaires at the Polish Legation in Tehran, was known to have made a "recruitment" approach while on a trip to Kabul, Afghanistan, in mid-1955.
