ON BALANCE, WE WOULD RATHER LET THE MONEY BE DELIVERED TO THE [redacted] AND PRESERVE OUR SOURCE AGAINST THE DAY WHEN HE CAN WARN US OF THE ACTUAL OUTBREAK OF TROUBLE IN PANAMA. TAKE NO ACTION TO INTERFERE.
