At that time, he began working full time as editor of Juana Castro's radio programs over WNYW at a salary of \$300 per month. He continues to receive a pay check from the Agency which is presently being funded through a notional cover firm out of New Jersey. Mr. Alles was witting of Agency sponsorship of AMHIM and is witting of Juana Castro's involvement with the Agency.
