I received a telephone call 3 November 1977 from Mr. John Crowell, Assistant General Counsel for Rockwell International, Dallas, Texas. Mr. Crowell confirmed that an out-of-court settlement had been reached by Rockwell with General Thomas Wood (Ret.), a former employee who had represented Collins Radio International. Mr. Crowell stated that no court action would result regarding Gen. Wood's separation from Rockwell and requested the appropriate Agency official be so notified. Furthermore, Mr. Crowell indicated it was his understanding that Mr. Sabani had returned to Iran. Mr. Sabani who possesses dual citizenship (U.S./Iran) was a former assistant to the General. No contact has been made by Mr. Sabani with Rockwell to date. Per Mr. Crowell's request, I am providing a copy of this memorandum to the Director, OSO, DDS&T.
