1. Subject is going to Latina, Cuba, on or about 15 August 1960, as a 1 to 2 week TDY in connection with several audio operations. He is traveling incognito, with alias documentation from New York City. Cover story is as follows:

Carswell entered on duty with the [redacted] as [redacted]  
 a [redacted] employee in October 1959, and remained with them until May 1960. He spent the majority of this period traveling on [redacted] 32 [redacted] business both within and outside of the U. S. He had little time to spend with his family and to remedy this situation he looked for employment in private industry in early 1960. He accepted the most attractive offer from the firm, and became associated with them as a production management consultant, at a salary of \$15,000 a year.

2. Carswell was briefed on the national concept type of backstop, the business of E-6\*, and his particular job. He was given business cards to put in his wallet, TSD is preparing alias documentation and Security furnished a backstamped New York address. Pertinent employment information on Carswell is being placed in New York (S-6\*) through (06) (K-2077). OCL was notified to block his DDCI cover and Agency personnel records were blocked. He will make his own travel reservations and notify OCB/PC upon return from TDY.
