1. Headquarters is now trying to arrange to have NOSENKO transferred from the USSR to Headquarters area. Because of the incidents raised in referenced cables, as well as derogatory information on file concerning the family of Subject's wife, it is not possible to convert NOSENKO to a Staff Agent or employee at this time. Headquarters is attempting to arrange to have NOSENKO brought to Headquarters in his present status under a new WH Project. You will be notified later of the details of this proposal after it has been determined whether such an attempt will be successful. In the meantime, no indication should be given to NOSENKO concerning what is being done regarding his future assignment.

2. However, in order to clear up his security file, it will be necessary to have a statement from the field, signed by the Chief of Station.

Also include a statement evaluating the Station's estimate of the security of NORFALL and his wife. It is requested that this memorandum be prepared as soon as possible and forwarded to Headquarters.
