1. On 10 January, the DD/Sec coordinated on a cable to Teheran asking the COS to confront [REDACTED] with the report that she had disclosed information to an outsider.

2. The following are the personalities involved in this matter:

- a. an unknown "contact" in ACSI/Pentagon of Lucien Consein;
- b. Lucien Consein (5025), ex-chief of the Military Liaison Group and the person to whom "a" told about Captain Kazerian's "special source";
- c. a Lt. Colonel Fox, Consein's successor as chief of MIG;
- d. Captain Kazerian, the number three (approximate) man in MIG;
- e. [REDACTED] an NE Division employee to whom Consein told the story of Kazerian's "special source";
- f. [REDACTED] DCOS, who is mentioned in the cable but who is involved only to the extent that Consein was instructed to report the story to [REDACTED]
