This will confirm verbal advice of 23 December 1959 that the writer advised Joseph KING, SO/OTR, that the Office of Security would not favorably entertain a request for the Subject's utilization in a staff capacity at [redacted] in view of his current non-staff status and cover and security considerations involved in connection with his current assignment in [redacted] as a Career Agent. It is understood that OTR will advise WH Division that OTR cannot assign the Subject to [redacted] for security and cover reasons.
