1. Mr. Moroney contacted the writer at 8:30 p. m. advising that he had received word that the subject would attempt to depart Cuba for the Florida Keys on 13 October 1961.

and to notify I&NS to [redacted]

[redacted] Mr. Moroney further advised that as an alternate for the subject, one [redacted] may come out. There was no further ident on [redacted]

2. Mr. McCarthy was notified of the above at about 8:45 p. m., 13 October 1961.

3. On 16 October 1961, Moroney had had no word of arrival. Moroney advised that Carlos BANDIN may come out too. Details later.

4. On 19 October 1961, neither I&NS nor WH had any further information on arrival.
