1. A summary of AAE's participation in the SP/10 recruitment program was included in referenced nemorandum. It is planned to carry out the assessment assignment as follows.24An AAE assessment psychologist documented as a consultant of will contact an unwitting candidate for the SP/10 REDSKIN program by telephone or correspondence. The candidate will be informed that the consultant is acting on behalf of confidential clients in the industry, education and government who have a variety of assignments overseas of varying duration and degrees of permanence. If the individual indicates availability the assessment psychologist will contact him in person and carry out an interview and whatever further assessment is possible under the cover.

- 2. Dr. Kenneth Bradt will be the psychologist on the AME Staff who will make the first assessments under this cover. He entered-on-duty with this Organization on 13 December 1954 and is at present a G3-13. In addition to his Agency duties he is a psychological consultant for the Applied Psychological Corporation, Arlington, Virginia. Dr. Bradt has been an overt member of the Agency during his entire career, with one exception: during December 1960 and January 1961 he was on a WH/4 project, the cover for which was provided by the operating division.
- 3. It is requested that the appropriate documentation be provided for Dr. Bredt and that the necessary steps be taken to protect his employment with the Agency.
- 4. Although Dr. Bradt is the only number of the A&E Staff who is to participate in this project, at this time it is anticipated that one
