2. We are attaching, for your additional information in this case, a report of an interview of the Subject by an officer of this agency who is known to the Subject as "Peters." You will note that a good part of this report has to do with an American named William STEINSMITH, who was mentioned in our CSCI-3/766, 845, of 21 August 1961. Additional information on STEINSMITH will be the subject of a subsequent report.
