1. Reference is made to this office's OSCI-3/766,612, dated 9 August 1961, consequing the above Subject.

- 2. We have recently learned that KANTUR has returned to Comerhagen, Demark from a trip to Regeslevia, and that he plans to depart for New York in early September. He has recently been in Caily contact with one William STEMSMITH, an American citizen born about 1933, who is convently living in Demark without a residence permit. We have been advised by a usually reliable source that STEMSWITH has maintained a clandestine contact with a Cuban official in Coperation, and that he has sold pro-CASTRO articles to the local Demark press. We have also been advised that LANTUR recently obtained a check for \$1000, ontenably from his father, to pay for his fare back to the United States.
- 3. We will forward to you any additional information we may receive in the matter. It is suggested, in the meantime, that it may be in order to accurating if possible, whether KANTON's father has in fast recently acquired the above-mentioned sum and forwarded it to the Subject.
