- 3. I have read the provisions of Public Law 513 of 13 May 1950. I understand that I am bound by that Act even after the revocation of . my cryptographic clearance and my termination from CIA, and that improper disclosure of cryptographic information could subject me to punishment under the provisions of the Act.
