Morales advised that he currently has available a boat in the target area to be utilized in the landing of four indigenous ~~persons~~ in Key West Florida - the boat ~~is~~ is capable of travelling to U.S. waters and then

returning to the base & area. Two
plans call for [redacted] to
 rendezvous with the vessel and use
 rubber raft in the Key West Waters
 and make the landing on a selected site
 in Key West. This landing is scheduled
 for the week end of 6-7-8. May

Morales and [redacted] are to
 coordinate their activities with
 priority call with Reckhardt. The
 latter or [redacted] will advise me
 of the exact date of arrival and the site
 for the landing. Since the landing
 is to be made by raft [redacted] will
 travel to Key West with some at which
 time I can accompany him to identify
 the landing site. After landing the
 individuals will be furnished a point
 of destination by Reckhardt.
