Reference is made to the memorandum dated July 13, 1966, prepared by Charles William Thomas, Political Officer, entitled "Further on Oswald and Kennedy Assassination".

A confidential source who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on October 10, 1966, that a record had been located at the Hotel Vermont, Vermont #29, Mexico, D. F. disclosing that Elena Paz, housewife from San Luis Potosi, San Luis Potosi, Mexico, had registered at the Hotel Vermont on November 23, 1963, leaving November 24, 1963, again registering on November 25, 1963, leaving November 27, 1963, and again registering on November 28, 1963, leaving November 30, 1963.

The above individual may or may not be identical with Elena Garro de Paz referred to in referenced memorandum.
