THE STATION REPORTED IN EARLY OCTOBER 1963 THAT LIENVOY COVERAGE HAD BEEN SUSPENDED ON 23 SEPTEMBER 1963 ON TWO CUBAN EMBASSY LINES: 14-92-14 AND 25-07-95. COVERAGE ON 14-92-14 WAS SUSPENDED BECAUSE IT WAS OUT OF ORDER, AND THE CUBANS HAD NOT SUCCEEDED IN GETTING THE TELEPHONE COMPANY TO REPAIR IT. 25-07-95 WAS SUSPENDED BECAUSE IT WAS LOCATED IN AN APARTMENT WHICH HAD BEEN VACATED BY A CUBAN OFFICIAL AND THE CUBANS HAD NOT YET SUCCEEDED IN HAVING IT TRANSFERRED TO THE CUBAN EMBASSY.
