SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

Mr. [redacted] MR/Adm., called the Security Duty Office to report, for the record, the death of Mr. Phillips' daughter. Mr. Lawer stated he had no details except that the girl was killed in an automobile accident sometime last night. Mr. Phillips had notified Mr. Lawer of the accident earlier this date and stated that further assistance was needed at this time. [redacted] noted that Mr. Thomas Karanessinos, DDS, was also notified. (Mr. Karanessinos requested that the Office of Security be advised.) Mr. Phillips is under cover for [redacted]

The Evening Star, dated 24 August, reported that Miss [redacted] Young Phillips, age 15, was killed when the car in which she was riding collided with another car on Bradley Boulevard in Bethesda. The accident occurred around midnight.
