INCIDENT:

1. While conducting a security patrol in 300m 2015, Barton Hall at 2200 hours on 22 April 1960, Geard G. L. Samuels found a sheaf of classified documents in a metal correspondence divider on top of one of the desks. The Hight Security Officer determined that the documents were SECRET copies of official dispatches which he impounded at 2215 hours.

HAVE THE TIME!

- 2. Fiss custodian of the documents, advised that she must have inadvertently overlooked them when she secured her office before departing at about 1720 hours on 20 April 1960.
- 3. Kiss who was working with hise secured her working area in Hoom 2015 at the same time as did hiss when she departed a few minutes after hiss of the secured by Hiss with exposed documents which had been left unpropriate to charge him with a violation of security regulations since essentially her departure was timed with that of hiss and her being last to leave the room is considered to be a technicality.
 - h. Hr. David Phillips, Wil/h Staff Duty Checker on 22 April 1960, double checked Room 2015 after it had been vacated for the day and prior to 1.00 hours. He also stated that he did not see the exposed documents.

CONCLUSION:

As custodian of the exposed classified material, Eiss was responsible for its secure storage. As the Staff Duty Checker, Er. Phillips was responsible for detecting the fact that classified material had not been properly secured. As each failed to properly discharge his respective responsibility in this matter, each will be charged with an Exposed Classified haterial security violation.
