1. At 4:55 p.m., 20 April 1960, [redacted] of WH Division, called to inform that the subjects had arrived at Miami from Havana and were about to be returned to Cuba. [redacted] asked me to see if I could have them paroled in and stated he would request their parole under the S. P. Agreement.

2. Mr. McCarthy, I&NS, arranged for them to be paroled, and informed me the subjects wanted to go to Caracas as soon as possible. He did not know at that time whether or not they would be permitted to do so.

3. Today [redacted] called to request that I arrange for the subjects to go to Caracas. This arrangement was made and Mr. McCarthy informed me the subjects would depart for Caracas on PAA Flight No. 433 at 12:45 a.m. today.
