About two weeks ago Mr. []⁰³, OO/C extension 3026, called and said that they needed an interpreter for a Soviet Delegation for one afternoon and Subject had been selected. Mr. [Sounitza]⁰³ said that Mr. Kuhn had given his approval recently on the Subject.

Mr. []⁰³ said that a new exchange program is now under negotiation.
