

Addendum to Journal - Office of Legislative Counsel Friday - 28 October 1977

- 5. (Secret. PG) LIAISON Received a telephone call from Peter Stockton, on the staff of the Subcommittee on Energy and Power, House Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce. Mr. Stockton wished to inquire as to whether we had received and understood a recent letter on NUMEC from Chairman John D. Dingell (D., Mich.). I told him that I had and informed him of the arrangements we projected for briefings. There ensued a long discussion as to Mr. Stockton's preferences for the mode of briefing, which I informed him I could not guarantee. It was left that I would check with the appropriate CIA element, and inform Mr. Stockton of the results when I had them.
- 6. (Genfidential DTC) LIAISON Talked to G. Robert Blakey, Chief Counsel, and Staff Director, House Select Committee on Assassinations, to make arrangements for staff personnel to review certain DDO documents here at Headquarters on 30 October.
