SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

(U) Agency Operator transferred a call from SUBJECT who stated that she has information concerning the John F. Kennedy assassination. The information, which she would not divulge, was available if the Agency is willing to "pay" for it.

(U) SUBJECT stated that she wanted to speak to an Agency representative and would not reveal anything over the telephone.

(U) SUBJECT was told that a report of her call would be made and forwarded to the appropriate office where a decision would be made as to the merit of her offer.
