<p>"Enquiries in the Montreal area revealed that AZCUE entered Canada on approximately 5 November 1965 and remained until 17 December 1965. Although AZCUE came to our attention on several occasions during his visit, we were unable to learn anything of intelligence value concerning him. His activities, to our knowledge, were confined to making arrangements concerning the Cuban Government's proposed building at EXPO 67.</p> <p>"Should we receive any additional information relative to AZCUE, you will be advised accordingly. We, <u>unfortunately</u>, were unable to obtain advance notice concerning his return to Cuba."</p>
