In reference to our memorandum of 29 January 1962, the Field advised via WAVE 1511 dated 20 February 1962, that they are aware of the remarks attributed to the above listed Subject concerning KUBARK policy and personnel. The Field further advised that Subject was one of many who took this view at that time due mostly in anger over the failure of the April 1961 invasion attempt.

Subject is now reportedly cooperative and secure and as such will be an invaluable asset to the JMWAVE project. In view of this, it is requested that processing of Subject's Provisional Operational Approval be continued.
