- RID files revealed several references on Subject. also know as: George S. de MOHRENSCHILDT, George Sergius de MOHRENSCHILDT, Jerzy Von MOHRENSCHILLT, and Jerry Von MOHRENSCHILDT, who was born on 17 April 1911 in Mozyr, Ukraine, U.S.S.R., a former Polish citizen who became a naturalized United States citizen in Denver, Colorado, in 1847. The Office of Strategic Services File No. 13526, in RID Archives, contained some background and correspondence material concerning de MOHRENSCHILDT. Copies of the material in this file have been consolidated into Subject's 201 file 201-725439 which is forwarded herewith, on permanent charge to Hr 03 Three index cards referred to RID Microfilm card material which is filed in Subject 201. Checks were made at WH/Mexico, SR/6, and EE/Poland for possible information on Subject and SR/6 and EE/Poland had no record. The 201 file for Subject contains the material found in the records of WH/Mexico. Three reference cards referred to the file of the Office of Security, and the material from this file is contained in the 201. The Central Cover Staff has no record of Subject.
- Subject is not listed in the Dallas, Texas, Telephone Directory, nor does his name appear in Who's Who in the Southwest er any other Who's Who or professional listing. The only petro-leum consultant listed by the Dallas Telephone Directory is located in the Republic National Bank Building, Dallas 1, Texas, is one Clarence M. NETHERLAND. Marquis-Who's Who in America, Page 8,236, described Subject's brother, Dimitri von MORRENSCHYLDT, born 11 April 1902 in St. Petersburg, U.S.S.R., as an editor, an educator, a lecturer, and an author in Russian History and Siavic Culture, and one who holds doctorate degrees from Yale and Columbia Universities.
- For possible additional information on Subject, it is suggested that a check be made with OO/C through Mr. SCHREYER's A copy of this memorandum is being forwarded to RID for classification into Subject's 201 file.
