For some months [redacted] ¹⁶⁻⁸ has successfully intercepted George de MOHRENSCHILDT's personal mail, securely monitoring those letters indicated in DIR-41342, DIR-81595, and DIR-82820.</p> <p>2. The original purpose for intercepting DE MOHRENSCHILDT's ¹⁶⁻⁸ mail was to tell us Subject's correspondents outside Haiti. Today [redacted] has such an excellent list of names and addresses of Subject's worldwide acquaintances that current incoming letters almost always bear the same addresses previously reported.</p> <p>3. [redacted] ¹⁶⁻⁸ would like to know if Headquarters ¹⁶⁻⁸ has a continued interest in all of Subject's mail. If not, [redacted] will discontinue reporting previously reported addresses and will continue to monitor those letters from individuals noted in DIR cables mentioned in paragraph one above.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>William S.
