3. For Headquarters information U.S. Ambassador Timmons has ordered all Embassy personnel to avoid any contact with the de MOHRENSCHILDT's. The culminating incident in a long series of indignities allegedly perpetrated by the de MOHRENSCHILDT occurred when Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT pursued the Embassy receptionist into the Ladies Room and rudely slapped that young victim.
