Memo for the record

Subject: Visa Application of Wife of Marcos DIAZ Leng

1. Mr. Massett (X2141) told me this moreing that State has no record of the wisa application of Sra. DIAZ lanz. If one has been submitted to the American Embassy in Habana, it has not been forwarded up here for an advisory opinion. State has flagged her name and will notify Massett (or Mr. Cotter or Mr. Penmington of the same office) whenever her case is submitted for an opinion.

2. Since current plans call for her evacuation from Cuba to Mexico, rather than direct to the U.S., there is not the urgency that there was before in getting her a U.S. visa. However, when the matter calls up after her arrival in Mexico, we should expedite the forwarding of her application to State so that processing may proceed.
