MEXCRASION FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Contact With Sr. Manuel Antonio DE VARONA 11 July 1961

1. In response to a call to Benier from VAROMA, the undersigned called TAROMA 11 July 1951 at the Roosevelt Hotel, Mashington, D.C., Room 707, and in the course of the conversation VIROMA brought up the following points:

a. The problem of the magistrates.

The problem of INISOIAN.

c. The problem of three of the prisoners from the invasion force who are in the United States in connection with the tractor negotiations and who, Sr. VARCHA stated, are "stranded" at the Harriott Motel. VARCHA would like \$1,000.00-\$1,500.00 to send these three men to New York and back to Mismi in connection with their efforts.

2. VAROMA also referred to a plan to send three Cubans, including a labor leader, on an anti-CASTRO mission to Latin America at a cost of about \$6,500.00 for each person. He also referred to the reported promises of support for himself and his family, referring and "Bender" as those who had guaranteed the
