OGTROSE/Operational ARSWIRL-1

- INTRODUCTION. In order to more precisely clarify your responsibilities for AMSWIRL-I the below listed information is being forwarded in an attempt to clearly describe the nature and scope of the activities with which we believe AkS41AL-1 should be associated. It is felt that a clear celineation of your responsibilities relative to ARSAIRL-1 as well as a restatement to AESTIAL-1 of his mission on our behalf in the JACAR area should minimize any possibilities that we might find ourselves embarressed by ANNIKL-I's present or future activities. The below listed charter for ARSVIEL-1 has been discussed by Andrew E. REUTERAN with IDEA A, Supervising ODDOCA Agent, Elani, IDIN B, District Director of Charge, and Kelvin W. SBOLGOY, Chief of Coa Locks. All of these gentlemen concurred heartily in this charter. This should insure that there will be a minimum amount of frietion in the JEDAR area in the future between CDUNGE, ODBON, AKSVIRL-1 and AUBARK.
- 2. SCOPE OF ANSTIRL-1'S ACTIVITIES. It is believed that the following items clearly define the n-ture and scope of ANSWIRL-1's activities in the JKBAR area on behalf of KUBARE. These activities are:
- a. Collection of Priority Positive Intelligence. It is envisioned that ALLEIM.—I will Initial this responsibility by the timely debriefing of those refugers the enter PRPRIME via the JERMA area. In this connection ANSWIRL—I must understand that he cannot get access to these individuals until they are at least primarily processed by ODURGE. significant charges in PDEUMIN's governmental or military structure. This collection effort is designed solely to obtain priority perishable intelligence, and it is not designed to replace, duplicate or compete with CAC.

- b. Spot Potential Sources who hay have Viable Operational Leads. In the course of AKSVINI-1's debriefing of refugees for priority positive intelligence be should also assess these individuals relative to any operational leads which they might possess. In this connection he is only to identify such leads and then report this information to JEMAVE by the most expeditions manner possible. This will insure that JEWAVE then has the opportunity to follow-up on these leads when the refugee in question arrives at CAC. Here again, it is important that AKSVIRL-1 understand that he is a primary flushing mechanism, and, as such, he is to identify individuals who warrant a more thorough detriefing either by CAC or by JEWAVE. Under no circumstances is AMSVIEL-1 to attempt to compete with or duplicate CAC's or JEGAVE's exploitation of the refugee flow in an attempt to find exploitable operational leads.
- e. Quick Turn-Around Agent Condidates. As AksWIRL-1 processes tacked refugees he should pay attention to fishing boat personnel in an attempt to determine whether some of these individuals can be recruited and turked around in a matter of hours prior to the time that their departure from PERCHEN will be noticed. If such a quick turn around lead is identified AKSWIRL-1 should utilize JEBAR facilities for requesting assistance from JEWAVE to mount an operation with the prospective quick turn-around agent. If time does not permit JEMAVE's rendering such assistance then at the discretion of Chief of Base, JEBAR this lead can be followed up by JEBAR personnel as appropriate. In such a follow-up it is imperative that AMSWIRL-1 be cut out of the operation at as early a time as it is possible to achieve.
- d. Counterintelligence Leads. ANSTIRL-1 is also charged with the responsibility of attempting to spot CI suspects from among those PERCHENS who either enter PEPRIME as refugees via the JHRAR area or who are already residents of the JHRAR area. It is clear, however, that ANSTIRL-1 only has a spotting responsibility with regard to this mission. Once a potential CI suspect is spotted no further action is to be taken on this natter by ANSTIRL-1 or JHRAR until such time as full coordination has been affected with JMFAVE. In most instances when this coordination has been affected the CI lead will be followed up by JMFAVE and/or JMBAR. ANSTIRL-1 will have fulfilled his responsibilities in the CI field at such time as he has brought the potential suspect to our attention.
- e. Procurement of Documents, Beasons and Other Lelated Items. AKSWIRL-1 is also charged with the mission of procuring from incoming refugees selected categories of high priority documents, weamons and other related items. This procurement effort should, however, be kept to a minimum as too aggressive an effort in this field can complicate the refugee processing system at CAC. Specific guicance will be forwarded on a regular basis to JMBAR for passing to AKSWIRL-1 relative to the types of documents, weapons and other related items which should be obtained on a priority basis. In addition to this list it is assumed that both JMBAR and AkSWIRL-1 will exercise imagination, sound judgment and discretion in procuring other items which are of an obvious intelligence nature and which may appear in the JKBAR area on a target of opportunity basis.
- 3. SUPERVISION. AMSWERL-1 is regarded as a JKBAR asset and the initial first echelon supervisory responsibility for AMSWERL-1 clearly rests with JMBAR. In view of this it is believed

that Chief of Base, JEBAR should be in direct contact with the senior CDURGE representative in the JEBAR area. EURARE requests to CDURGE in the JEBAR area should be handled by Chief of Base, JEBAR rather than by AESVIEL-1. It is the intent of this dispatch to minimize the circumstances and occasions on which AESVIEL-1 should be acting on behalf of LUBARE. The intent of the AESVIEL-1 relationship is to utilize CDURGE cover for the accomplishment of a KUBARE operational support mission. This means that in those instances where AESVIEL-1 surfaces his EUBARE relationship in order to accomplish his EUBARE mission be is seriously defeating the primary purpose of our having worked out this rather unique relationship with CDURGE. It would be appreciated if you would bear this factor in mind in all future dealings with AESVIEL-1 and the ODTOKE agencies which are in the JEBAR area and who have an interest in the PERMEN problem.
