A Cuban emigre with excellent contacts is several emigre organisations in Hissi. He has been an accurate reporter on those organizations and on general emigre political developments since about mid-1952.

- Representatives of the Miami and Puerto Rico chapters of the Centro Cubano de Estudies Politicos (CCLP. Cuban Center for Political Studies) met in San Juan, Puerte Pico, on 20 August 1966 to start making plans to hold a CCLP congress. On the Juda this ten inait nor actagele sert, taugua 16 to nairrom six numbers of the Puerto Rico delegation for preliminary discussions on the agenda for the afternoon meeting. At this aceting Rufo Lopez Presquet, a leader of the Puerto Rico chapter. was consured for his irreconcilable position regarding the exclusiveness of the proposed congress. ? Hanuel Pay Rivero, another member of the Puerto Rico branch, expressed concern that Lores' attitude would disrupt the preparations for, or isoperdize the effectiveness of the congress. 3 key said that he is prepared to disband the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURL. Cuban Revolutionary Junta), but will not do se until there is assurance that the CCLP will become an effective organization. Lopez received applause when he addressed the group, and promised to refrain from creating difficulties for the CCLP. and to devote his time and energy toward making the congress 2 success.
- 2. The following agreements were reached at the afternoon meeting, which was attended by about 20 members of the Puerto Rico chapter and the three delegates from Himmi:
 - . The Congreso Ravolucionario Cubano (Cuban Revolutionary Congress) will be held in Hismi from 2 to 5 February 1967.

- 6. CCLF caspters will be established in hew York. Los Angeles. end Chicago, and in Caracas. Venesuels.
- 8. Has Lesnick henender, a dieni delegate, was designated to prepare a rejort on the results of the meeting which will be sussitted to the Puerto Rico CCEP for approvel after which a public discountement on the position of the CCEP will be made.
- the CCLP in minimi held discussions to determine the position of their organization on the tolics which were to be discussed. It was agreed that the Minni chapter would favor holding a congress which would be solely for the purpose of consolidating and advancing the CCLP. The creation of a Partido de la Revolucion Cubana (PRC. Party of the Cuban Revolution), a proposed political party, should not be considered at the congress. In early August some members of the Powrte Rico chapter expressed their agreement with the position of the Mine chapter.

- 2. This meeting was originally scheduled to be held in Hiami from 2 to 4 July. (Cf. UFG-8426)
- 2. Lopes' views are reported in UTC-8426.

Source Comments

- A "major problem" between Lopes and Ray appears to have been resolved after lengthy discussions, at which other members of the CCEP acted as mediators, in early August.
- 4. Although an earlier date was desired, the group was unable to agree on a date. Fay said that a JURE rounion, which could not be postponed, was scheduled to be held during the third week of Hovember. December was not considered because of the holidays, and, following that, January is spent paying all of the Christmas bills."
- 5. All members of the CCEP will be eligible to attend the congress. A representative of each of the two branches will determine who will be invited from areas where there are no CCEP chapters. CONFIDENTIAL

- 6. Both the CCEP and the splinter proup which publishes fevolucion have discussed creating the PRC. The main difference appears to be in the timing. The CCEP feels that it would be presented to attempt to form a political party at this time, while the fevolucion group, considered redical by the CCEP, fevore forming the party immediately. (Cf. UFG-8476, UFC-8443, and UFG-8477)
- 7. UTG-8976 incorractly identified numes as inrique numes Gomes, with the comment that he sight be identical with a person by the same name who was formerly associated with the Second National Front of the Escantray (SFEC).

Available information indicates that Enrique Numes Alvares was also formerly associated with the SPME. By early 1966 be was living in Puerto Rico and was associated with JURE.

- *8. ** Rabala may be identical to Felix Tabala Mas who was a member of the SPNE-Alpha: %6 is Puerto Rico, and supported Vectors's faction of that group.
- 9. Veciana is probably Antonio Veciana Blanch, a former leader of Alpha-66.
- 10. Quades may be identical to Emilio Guede who was reported to be a member of the Exile Delegation of JURE in July 1965. He was believed to be identical with Emilio Guede Fernandes. (Cf. UPJ-7471)
