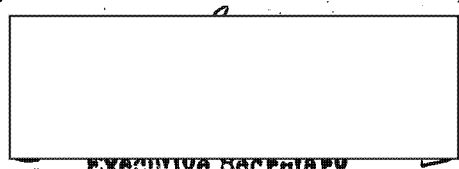
MEMORANDUM FOR: All Members, Interagency Defector Committee

SUBJECT: Notification of Defection, DB-2137

1. Subject is Anatoly Mikhaylovich KLIMOV. He was assigned to the Soviet Embassy in Helsinki in July 1960 and defected to the United States Government in Finland in December 1961. He was accompanied in his defection by his wife and daughter. They were flown commercially to Stockholm where they were picked up and moved to the United States via Frankfurt.

2. For the time being, maximum security is being exercised in the handling of Subject and it is requested that all addressees treat this defection on a strict need-to-know basis.

3. Attached is preliminary biographic data on Subject. The number, DB-2137, has been assigned.
