SUBJECT: AELADLE/1 Chance Meeting with Petr DERYABIN

SR officer assigned to the AKIADLES has reported that on Saturday, 6 January 1902, he and one of the Security Officers accompanied AKIADLE/1 to Ray's Barber Shop in Vienna, Virginia for a haircut. Upon leaving the barber shop at about 1730 hours, they accidentally met Petr DERYABIN who was walking in the opposite direction. DERYABIN recognized ARIADLE/1 instantly, and the two shook hands and greeted each other enthusiastically. DERYABIN inquired about AEIADLE/1's family, and AEIADLE/1 said that they were well and were with him. AEIADLE/1 asked DERYABIN if he had married, to which DERYABIN replied that he had, and that as of the day before yesterday he was the proud father of a son. DERVABIN presented a cigar to each of the others. DERYABIN "When will all this be in the newspaperst" Mr. replied that he didn't know. Mr. | congratulated | DERYABIN on the birth of his son and tolk nim and ARIADLE/1 that the street corner was not an appropriate place to talk. The others agreed, and they parted.
