- l. Transmitted herewith are the following:
 - A. A five-page report of RXXIII interrogation of Harry Alfons SUMDVIK on 25 April 1961
 - A two-page memorandum from SNDVIK covering ; wints he had forgotten during the interrogation
- 2. When reading the attached interrogation report, there are a number of points to be noted. First of all, SUNERLE's first story was a lie and it was only when he was pressed by ROODING that he hade any Lamtion of his meetings with KLIMOV. Therefore, this story could be only the second line of defense and not a true story of their relationship. Second, the story does not attempt to explain why, when Schullk had a week off from work (from Schurday, 8 April to Sunday, 16 Appil), he only spent the four middle days on his trip instead of utilizing the rest of his time. Third, way alimov persisted until the last moment and made arrangements to see SUNDAL again socially in selsinki if he had really "lost his grip" to SUNDVIK's superior arguments and hostile attitude as SUNDVIK states. Anyway, to say the least, we are not ready to accept SUNDVIK's story as it stands. "e has been asked to write out in detail, at least five single-space typewritten pages, the history of his contacts with ALINOV. We will check this paper against the report in hand, for a starter.
- 3. VALINK/6 is being kept informed of the details of this case. He agrees with ROODING that there is a good daal more than has been revealed so (By the way, we might mention that this is another case in which V.LI.IK/6 and the help of the VALINK organization have been invaluable. They have provided full background reports on all concerned, and have been surveilling SUHDVIK off and on ever sines we expressed our interest in him.)
- 4. As far as KLIMOV's statements about COSTILLE and MOCDINE got this was only to be expected and does not surprise either of them. For the history of COSTILLE's previous encounters with KLT v, see OFHA 4981, 20 Harch 1961. ROODINE YHAYYY has never met KLINOV.
- 5. The Ambussador, the Counselor, the Security Officer and the General Services Officer (SUNDVIK's immediate boss) are aware of this case. The interregation took place in the Security Officer's office. Only ROODING and SUMDVIK were present, but FURSTUSS was in the adjoining office listening through the wall.
- We still have not figured out exactly how to handle this case. BUNDVIK will eventually to dismissed, but we would like to get swap more information before we let go of him. Anyway, since he has been working at the ambassy since 1949 there is not much to be gained by throwing him out tomorrow. We has volunteered that he will be seeing KLINOV in the next few days to collect the bottle of vodka mentioned on page five of Attachment A, and we would like to hear the story of the meeting. It is justified that we might ask for analytance to LCFLUTTER CUNDVIK, if this in feasible, since a lot might be learned from this. (SUNDVIK's command of English is excallent, as without Attachment B, wilds he propored by himself.) One thing we do not intend to suggest, and that is a double-agent operation. Considering the position he holds, SUNDVIK is too tangerous to us. We can just imagine KLIMOV licking his chops when he first
