SUBJECT: AELADLE (CAVATA) POSSIBLE PARTICIPATION ABOUT AELADLE

ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

ACTION: For your information

1. The following information acquired from a source described as reliable was provided by alias Fleming. He explained that the information is being made available so that KUBARK can have an indication of the probable extent to which information provided by AELADLE has been spread around.

The Bonn representative of the "Frankfurter Rundschau," F. MOERSBACH, Cologne, who is well acquainted with the [redacted] Werner PAETSCH, has learned from PAETSCH that a so-called "AELADLE Protocol" exists in the U.S. This material contains statements of a Soviet officer who defected to the West in 1962 and told American agencies that the Soviets decided in 1954 to abduct Otto JOHN. [redacted] (CAVATA) was informed by the U.S. agencies and subsequently sent a delegation to the U.S. to inspect the AELADLE material. PAETSCH claims to have received extracts made in the U.S. for translation into German.

2. Fleming stated further that [redacted] (CATIDE) intends to inform [redacted] (CAVATA) of the release of classified material by PAETSCH, who, according to Fleming's information is expected to become a witness in a trial which Dr. JOHN has asked for and in which he hopes to rehabilitate himself.
