The newspaper picture of Subject submitted with reference was shown to AKD/PPNR/20 who said that GOLUB's face was familiar to him, and when the name was furnished Source stated there was a Lt. Colonel of this last name in the MGB. Source did not know which directorate Lt. Col. GOLUB was in - might be the technical section - but he knew that GOLUB was a "fairly high boss." Source could not recall whether he had ever seen Subject so does not know if the GOLUB in the newspaper picture is one and the same with Lt. Col. GOLUB of the MGB.
