For the record, Reference B forwarded a REDCAP Notebook sheet on Grigoriy GOLUB, which full name was obtained in the debriefing of Arthur J. Lohwater. For the time being, therefore, we are carrying Subject on our records as Grigoriy Ye. GOLUB (the initial "YE" is transliterated by us to read "Ye"). Headquarters still has no traces, other than the Lohwater information (OFHA 1282, OFHA 1792, OFHA 1813, OFHA 1608) and VACCINE/1's report, OFHA 2148. We have received a travel report from you, OFHA 2082, 16 November 1956, which lists one Nina GOLUB, born 1927, arriving in Finland on 5 November 1956 "to reside permanently".
