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"" Replaced Ivan Yefimovich SERCEYEV, known RIS. DR-20-1239 Subj's face was familiar to source; when given the name source stated that there was a Lt. Col. of this last name in the MCB. Source did not 26 Jul 57 know which directorate he was in - might be technical section - but ARDIPPER20 knew that he was a "fairly high boss." Source could not recall whether he had ever seen Subj so does not know if this is the same person. Early Aug 57, Subj called on [VACCINE/1] & select that [V/1] warm him in OFBA-2072 adv. of any Sov official were about to be pag'd from Finland & he would 19 Oct 57 personally see to it that the man left quietly & immediately. (V/1)01 VACCIBLE replied in stern & angry manner, "Since when does a little diplomat w/ low rank of 2d Sec presume that he is so powerful as to remove official of his own country from Finl? If you are really that powerful, who are you anyway & what are your real duties here in Finl?" Subj disturbed did not pursue the question. (Sta Comment: Subj's question interesting in view of BOORNING oper. Trying to determine date of chat.) Subj mentioned sourc's imminent trip to USSR. Subj told source to come to Sov Emb next day to meet the Cultural Attache, who could arrange to get source to USSR & back without cost. Source invite Subj and RASKE to his home for dinner following Sunday. Both accepted. Subj paid entire bill. When source went Sov Emb next day met Yuriy VORCHIE & Subj, also SERCEYEV. V. invited himself to dinner with Subj at source's home. Subj, VORORIN & wives went source's for dinner, bearing many presents. RASKE did not come. Subj told source "this RASKE is a swine." Felt that it necessary to use these Finn Commies politically but that they cannot be trusted. OPEX-2413 Subj had contact w/Prof David Becht (Fulbright), a Russian speaking research scholar whose interest is 19th century Russia. Hecht, through 9 Apr 57 Hilliker (Ch/Pol Sec), met Jane Kichline who obtained a report for Eqs. Hecht reported that COLUB very down on the Am Emb & America. Wanted to mow about American life in U.S., etc. HISCELLANCOUS Source balieved Ivan Te. SERCEYEV is Subj's chief. See (WHI-1282, COTHAL1792, COTHAL1813, which produte the debriefing of Arthur J. Lohnster (Debriefing changes some of the points.) [YACCIER/1] invited to a farevell lunch for Ivan Yefimovich SERCEYEV (known RIS who used title of Consul in Finl at times) 17 Dec 56. Also present was (fm) COLUB, who was introduced as the new Consul. Subj has been in Finland circa l yr. Subj & wife on Sov Emb list of Mar 57 (OFHA-2356). Subj & wife on Dip list Jan 57 (GFEA-2215). Subj & wife on Dip List of Jul 57 (GFEA7774). Wife to USSR by train 22 May 57 (GFEA-597). Subj & wife dptd Hels for Moscow by rail 22 Sep 57 77, 5 Oct 57) & Subj left Finl with family in early Sep & has not yet returned (GFEA-2872). Subj arr Finl from Moscov 6 Mov 57. [A mid-December, [VAIRGLORY/12] told [VARIATION] the following which O([V/1] passed to station. OOLUB had recently complained to Johannes VIROLATERS that the Firm security police were not paying any attn to cases of British & American espionage in Finl, adding that the Sove had info regarding Western espionage in Finl & would be glad to furnish it to the security police. DOLUB said some of the Western cases were ald a some new. Did not elaborate. Source did not say what VIROLAIMEN'S reply was to COLUE. [V/1] then said it would behoove AIS officers in Hels to be as careful as possible cause it quite possible security police would receive orders to keep their eyes sharply peeled for oper involving Firmish citizens. Pendleton briefed all senior CDEARL people. ODURIT man said he had rec'd a warning few days earlier from a friendly Finn offer that another CDUNIT offer had been seen too frequently driving a Volkswagen w/dipl plates around freight yards of Hels. (This was COURTT's energetic factory & freight car marking progrem.) The CDOATH man said his family had noticed Finn policeman on the best outside his house had recently begun to go to phone booth & make a call every time the senior CCOATH man left his house and drove towards town. Everyone took varning seriously. [V/1] to tell us any further developments. Ol On 31 Dec 57, [MRIATION/1] told Station that Subj had visited the Min of the Interior re security police having contacts with Westerners. [V/1]01 was told that it had no connection with him; Finl a free country & people had right to talk with any one they pleased. Min of Int asked him exactly what he was driving at - Subj was evasive & gave a vague non-sequitur asswer which gave no hint as to what proof the Soviets were talking about. Min of Int told COLUB if Sov govt had any official complaints to make he should make them thru proper channels. When asked if he thought there were any deeper significance to these Sov gambits, () [VARIATIOS/I] replied that he did not expect the Soviets to do enything more than drop these conversational hints.

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
