4. In January of this year TECHEORN travelled to Cuba on behalf of WH Division where he spent about two weeks assessing the political situation, with emphasis on ascertaining the strengths and weaknesses of the non-Communist groups, and investigating the possibilities of a coalescence of these groups into appolitical organization. At briefing sessions prior to his departure, TICHEORN demonstrated an immediate grasp of the type of mission proposed to him, and upon his return, revealed considerable insight into the Cuban situation.

- 5. Wil Division received two copies of the detriefing report in February. Briefly, some of the operational information and suggestions offered by TECHECRE are as follows:
 - a. There appears to be little chance of a coalition of the opposition groups at present since they are not well organized and, according to members of the opposition to whom TICHERN talked, CASTRU is in no present danger of losing the devotion of his followers
 - b. TICHECRE believes that inducement of defections among the CASTRO followers would have more effect on CASTRO then any other single action we might undertake.
 - c. There is a long-standing schize between Fidel and Kaoul CASTRO, which if exploited, could be operationally advantageous.
 - d. Most important, TIDESCRI emphasized that CASTRO must not be underestimated by the U.S., nor written off as suother Latin American revolutionary.
