

Edward G. Tichborn's bank is as follows:



The check for the \$2,000 operational advance was drawn on a check of the cover company. It was mailed from Washington with an accompanying letter written by Tichborn stating that it should be deposited to his Commercial Account. Date of writing and forwarding was 15 January 1960.

The \$650 check for $\frac{1}{2}$ of his total salary, should be mailed to the same bank and credited to his Commercial Account.
