

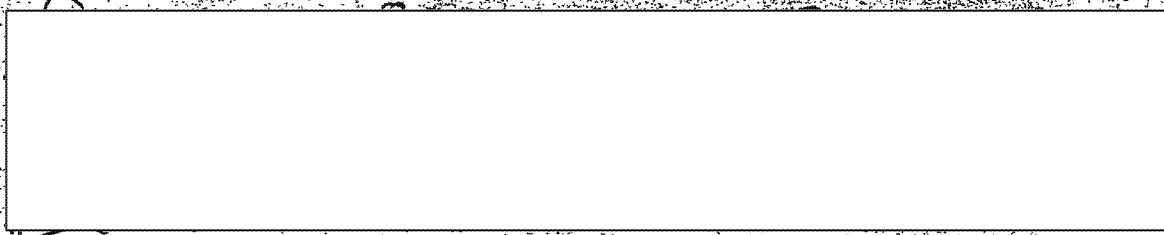

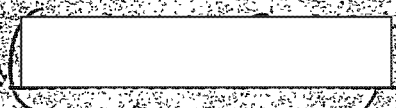
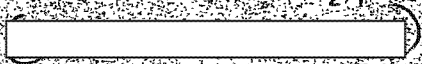
Dear Mr. Lopez: 05
