MEMORANDUM FOR: Mr. [redacted]

SUBJECT : Viola June Cobb and Lyle Stewart

1. Col. Grogan telephoned at 1310 hours today saying that he had just received a request from Mr. John O'Rourke of the Washington Post concerning the subjects.

2. Mr. O'Rourke says that ~~Stewart~~ ^{Lyle Stewart - "Independent"} is a "publisher" for Fidel Castro and June Cobb is a translator for Castro. She was recently kicked out of Guatemala where she had been working for Jacobo Arbenz. Recently Miss Cobb served as translator for the newly published book, The Shark and the Sardines by Juan A. Ravalo. Stewart is the publisher of this book.

3. Mr. O'Rourke would appreciate any background information that we might be able to provide concerning the subjects. Col. Grogan would like to help O'Rourke on this matter if it is possible.
