Pursuant to our earlier conversations on Subject, I wish to advise you that Subject has proved of long range value to the Agency as a controlled fellow traveler, and has also proved that she is a prime source on the Fair Play for Cuba Committee. As you know, the FBI has expressed an interest in such information that Subject can provide concerning the Fair Play Committee. I have no objection to an FBI interview of Subject if this can be done under circumstances which will not damage her operational potential for this Agency. I do strongly oppose, however, any use of Subject as a witness for any case developed by the Bureau against the Fair Play Committee.
