SUBJECT: Meeting with Representatives of the United States Internal American Council (USIAC)

REFERENCE: A WH/POA Memo Dated 9 January 1962, Same Subject

1. During subject meeting, Mr. Moore advised Messrs. Esterline and that his group was greatly concerned with the activities and portruel orientation of June Cobb. Mr. Moore noted that Miss Cobb had worked for Fidel Castro, had recently been in Guatemala where she had been arrested, and had since disappeared. It was his opinion that Miss Cobb had rejoined the Castro movement.

2. This information concerning Miss Cobb poses a problem in terms of a possible investigative action which the USIAC may try to instigate against her.
