Transmitted under separate cover are copies of four photographs found by CECIL CH and DCFRL Investigators among the joint personal effects left behind by Berrien Ferguson #MTCBLL (201-242137) and William Hamilton #MARTIN (201-282358) at the time of their departure from the United States on June 1 68 enroute to Hanoi City and thence to the USA. These photographs have been provided to KUBAB (or our liaison see only, except for permission to show them to ECCLANT) for their possible identification of the individuals depicted thereon.

2. The circumstances under which the photographs were found precluded the establishment of whether they were the possessions of or taken either with George SPERLING RCPULUS aka PERLIS (201-284530), known to have been a contact of MARTIN's, or with Mortimer Clagett #CCOKE, SR., recently deceased Teikyo Representative of the American Red Cross. For convenience in future reference in event of identification of any of these individuals, the pictures have been labeled A through D. The initials appearing on photographs A, C and D are completely obscured.

3. Attention is invited particularly to Photograph A, depicting an unidentified elderly Caucasian male, who is thought possibly to be identical either with George SPERLING RCPULUS aka PERLIS (201-284530), known to have been a contact of MARTIN's, or with Mortimer Clagett #CCOKE, SR., recently deceased Teikyo Representative of the American Red Cross. For convenience in future reference in event of identification of any of these individuals, the pictures have been labeled A through D. The initials appearing on photographs A, C and D are completely obscured.

4. It is requested that [REDACTED] attempt to establish the identities of these individuals, first by circulating among station personnel the photographs minus background data or other indication of the connection of these persons.
