1. Transmitted under separate cover in duplicate are copies of four photographs located by OLINCH and DUCAL investigators among the joint personal effects left behind by Beron Ferguson WITCHILL (201-242337) and William Hamilton MARTIN (201-282338) at the time of their departure from the United States in June 1 60 enroute to Mexico City and thence to the USSR. These photographs have been provided to KUHARA for our internal use only, except for permission to show them to ECCLAN/T for their possible identification of the individuals depicted thereon. 01

2. The circumstances under which the photographs were found precluded the establishment of whether they were the possessions of or taken by MARTIN or WITCHILL, although the backgrounds and the individuals appearing in the photographs between 11-1-51 and mid-1:55.

3. Attention is invited particularly to Photograph A, depicting an unidentified elderly Caucasian male, who is thought possibly to be identical either with George PERLSTEIN/CPULUS aka PERLS (201-284530), known to have been a contact of MARTIN's, or with Mortimer Claggett COCKER, Sr., recently deceased Tokyo Representative of the American Red Cross. For convenience in future reference in event of identification of any of these individuals, the pictures have been labeled A through D. The other individuals appearing on photographs B, C and D are completely unknown.

4. It is requested that 13-3 attempt to establish the identities of these individuals, first by circling among station personnel the photographs whose background data or other indication of the connection of these persons
