At the staff meeting this morning Mr. Maury said that he had had a recent conversation with Amhassador Thompson. Thompson this that the UPI correspondent. It is quite possible that she was really semewhat under the influence and not really noting disgracefully, but, there happened to be TASS correspondents and photographers near by while she was in high spirits and they took pictures of ber and wrote an article for the Soviet press showing how foreign press people acted in the Soviet Union. You should try to get whold of these articles if possible.
