"Originally worked for the New York Office of the FBI as a clerk. Since then he has been known to impersonate Federal agents, although he has not been apprehended for it. He is the ~~son~~ of Sherman Billingsley. ROARKE was jailed in Habana 1st year and feels that the State Department did not spring him quick enough--evidently he spent a couple of days in jail. Ever since he has been viciously attacking the State Department. His father is a U.S. federal referee and this guy is now unemployed and considered a pest. The local Bureau here avoids him like the plague--and possibly you might want to get a rundown from the Bureau. He might use us a springboard if we get too involved, but we will be glad to talk with him if you want us to.
